Khandro Rinpoche is a lay female Buddhist Meditation Master and director of a spiritual and humanitarian organization called "Khachodling".



Since childhood, Khandro Rinpoche has practiced pilgrimage with her family, visiting many Buddhist holy sites in the Indian Himalayas. Today she continues this tradition, regularly leading pilgrimages, mostly to the heart of the Himalaya. She has recently returned from her latest journey, overcoming record snowfalls, to participate in an annual ceremony at her family monastery aimed at removing obstacles in the world.
