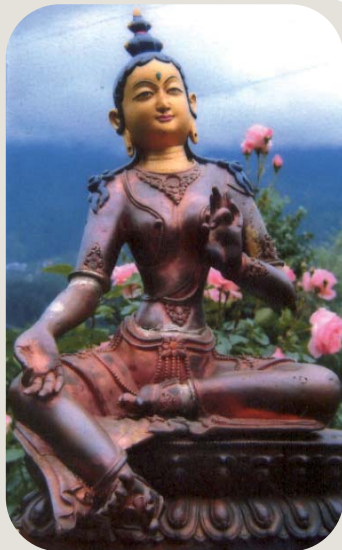

Khandro Thrinlay Chodon, holder of Togden Shakya Shri's yogic lineage, has made a commitment to teach and nourish her profound tradition, especially among female practitioners.

This began with 21 dedicated nuns in a remote high altitude hermitage in Zanskar in the Indian Himalayas. From here, these 21 nuns generate a power spot of Tara's enlightened activity for all to benefit. Their motivation and diligence is pure and they live far from the distraction of modern life.

Thanks to funds from Khandro-la's teachings last year, their simple mud huts were blessed with the construction of a Shrine Room in which they could practice. As funds become available the interior will be completed with a detailed carved altar that will house a central three foot Tara statue surrounded by 21 smaller Taras. Khandro-la's beloved Master, Imi Drupten, 82, a renowned statue filler, has agreed to fill and consecrate each of these Taras with his own hands. It is a matter of urgency to complete this project while he is still capable.

Through her many Khachodling activities she benefits others and bridges East and West.
